Ms Parikh spoke at length about values and their importance in life of youth today. She narrated incidents from life of Mahatma Gandhi and identified values from these narratives which, she felt the youth must imbibe in their lives.

Under Value Education programme, the Literary Association along with the NSS, and the F.C department of Maniben Nanavati Women’s College organised a cultural visit to Mani Bhavan, Mahatma Gandhi’s humble abode located in Grant Road as part of the institutional theme “Commemorating 150 years of Mahatma Gandhi: Gender Diversity for Peaceful Coexistence”. The students were enlightened about Gandhi’s life, his philosophies and his role in the freedom struggle through various models brought alive the memories of various historic milestones like the Jallianwallah Bagh massacre, Salt Satyagraha, the Swadeshi movement and the partition.
