Time: 8 am to 1:30 pm

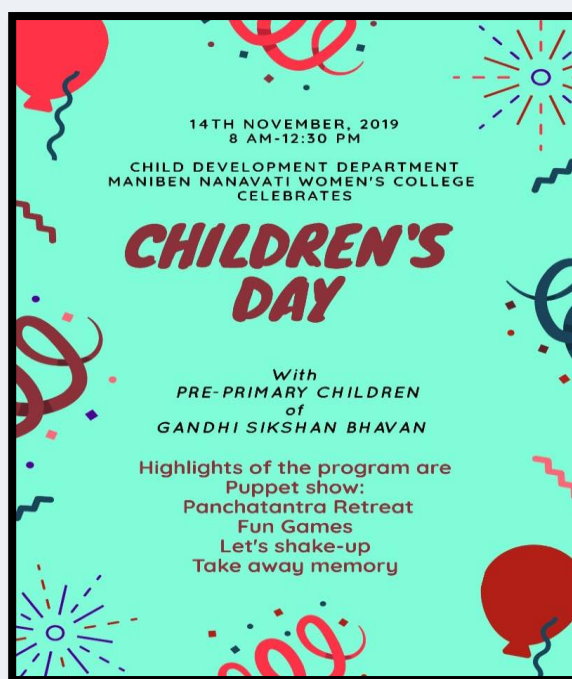
Number of participants(students and teachers):22 students and 1 teacher

REPORT

9:30am: Chacha Nehru arrived with children's day handmade badges which were distributed to all the preschool students as well as teachers. A brief child friendly introduction of children's day was made to create educative awareness in the preschool students.

9:50am to 10:10am: students of Maniben Nanavati Women's College conducted a puppet show showcasing their acquired skills of puppet story. The puppet story was based on a Panchatantra tale. The moral of the story was to plant trees and safeguard the existing trees.

10:30 am: the event was followed by enthusiastic edu-creative game of throwing the colored ball in the same colored shape. Teachers and students, both conducted the activity .
