The Annual Inter-College Research Competition Anveshan 2019-20 was **organised by Research Cell & UGC Sponsored Gandhian Study Centre**. The theme of the event was *Gender Diversity for Peaceful Coexistence*. The Event was held on Thursday, 30th January 2020. The Competition The event was sponsored by **Friedrich Ebert Stiftung**.

The Convenor of the conference was Dr.Cicilia Chettiar, Head, Department of Psychology &Dr.Sejal Shah, Co-Convenor, Head, Department of Gujarati.

The Competition had total of 28 entries from Humanities & Social Sciences from Under-graduate and Post-graduate section. The entries were received from Mumbai, Pune and Coimbatore.

The E-posters were sent to the judges for blind review. After the review 15 posters were shortlisted for oral presentation to the judges on 30th January 2020. Nine entries were from Under-Graduate Section (6 teams from Social Sciences & 3 teams from Humanities) & Six Entries from Post- Graduate Section.

The Shortlisted Participants presented their research work and they were allotted 10 minutes for their presentation followed by the Question and Answer Round. The total of 14 Teams came on the day of the finals. The Judges of the event were:
