


## 1. Mind power Session in collaboration with Mumbai Gujarati Sangathan for Grade 10 students




Guest Speaker: Ms. Alpa Rathod, Ex Assistant Professor of Resource Management Department, SNDT University

## 2. Mind power Session in collaboration with Mumbai Gujarati Sangathan for Grade 12 students




Guest Speaker: Mr. Parimal Desai - Model, Bollywood Actor, Artist
